

# ***CATEGORY 2 & CAB OPERATED CATEGORY 3 CRANE SAFETY***

**COURSE LENGTH:** 16 hours (2 days)

**CLASS SIZE:** 12-25 students

**TARGET AUDIENCE:** Personnel who will be assign to operate pendant or cab controlled Overhead Electric Traveling (OET) cranes and supervisors responsible for overseeing OET crane operations.

**SYNOPSIS:** This course is designed to provide a foundation for the safe operation of OET cranes. It covers specific OET crane terminology and safe operating procedures. Emphasis is placed on the individual responsibility to know the equipment and safety requirements. This course presents topics such as, NAVFAC P-307 familiarization, cranes and lift types, pre-use inspections, basic rules and procedures for safe operation, communication, specific lifting requirements, basic rigging gear inspection and use, determining load weights, calculating capacities, and crane accident response. This course provides a foundation for those who will be assigned to operate OET cranes full time or part time. This course, or the General Crane Safety course is required for licensing on Category 2 cranes.
