

CATEGORY 4 CRANE SAFETY

COURSE LENGTH: 24 hours (3 days)

CLASS SIZE: 12-25 students

TARGET AUDIENCE: Full-time or part-time Category 4 Crane operator trainees and their supervisors.

SYNOPSIS: This course is designed to help Category 4 operators use these cranes to lift and handle loads safely. Course topics include; Category 4 cranes types, pre-use inspections, basic safety procedures for safe operation, communication, specific lifting situations, basic rigging gear inspection and use, determining load weights, calculating capacities, and crane accident response. This course provides the student with a foundation of knowledge to build on using operator's manuals and on-the-job-training experience. This course, or the General Crane Safety course is required for licensing on Category 4 cranes.
