Subj: NRDL Residual Functions: disposal of Radiation Materials

1. By reference (a) the San Francisco Bay Naval Shipyard is directed to assume certain residual functions associated with the disestablishment of NRDL. One of these functions is the disposition of radioactive materials and the decontamination to final clearance levels of NRDL spaces. The extent of this function remaining will depend upon the disestablishment date as directed by the Chief of Naval Material. The projected date is now 3 November 1969 but is subject to change in an earlier direction.

2. Enclosure (1) indicates quantities of source, by-product and special nuclear materials for which the Laboratory is currently licensed. The actual quantities on hand do not exceed the possession limits indicated but do represent a reasonable approximation of the scope of the problem.

3. This residual function was discussed between NRDL (A. Smith) and SFBNSY (G. Rosati) on 24 June 1969. It is requested that the SFBNSY review the problem of this particular residual function and plan the necessary actions to accomplish the function; e.g., accomplish the necessary AEC licensing to permit possession, packaging for shipment and transfer or disposal of this material.

4. It is requested that this command be advised by July 3, 1969 of plans for
