Ref: (a) SFNS ltr 1438-32 11160 of 26 Mar 1959
 (b) NRDL ltr (CONP) 140-015 of 24 Sep 1958 to BuShips

1. Reference (a) explained the importance of Bldg. 364 to SFNS plans for new construction as well as present space needs and requested information as to when or whether NRDL can relinquish Bldg. 364.
2. NRDL requires the use of Bldg. 364 for the following programs:
 - a. Intermediate level isotope processing.
 - b. Simulant development and testing program for BuShips and OCIM.
 - c. Associated basic (small scale) decontamination studies.

All these programs are long term,

3. The Hot and Semi-Hot Engineering Facility Project 128E-1150, which was assigned Priority 4, Category - Essential in the FY 1961 Laboratory Shore Station Development Program, is the proposed replacement for Bldg. 364.
4. Reference (b) indicates the possibility of the Laboratory's vacating Bldg. 364 when space at Parks Air Force Base has been obtained from the Army. This has not come to pass as yet and at this time prospects are dim for developing a facility at Parks to substitute for Bldg. 364.
5. The Laboratory requires continuous use of Bldg. 364 until the proposed Hot and Semi-Hot Engineering Facility (128E-1150) becomes available.
