Subj: Assignment of SFNS Buildings to NRDL; extension of

Ref: (a) CO USNRDL ltr 141D-34 JIC:lrs of 17 Oct 1957

1. The Commanding Officer, U. S. Naval Radiological Defense Laboratory, by reference (a) reviewed the need for Shipyard Buildings assigned to NRDL and requested extension of the assignment of those buildings.
2. The assignment to the Naval Radiological Defense Laboratory of Buildings 364, 365, 510 (west portion), 510A, 517, 529, 707, and 708 (707A) is extended through 31 December 1958. It is requested that, prior to this date, a re-evaluation of the continued need be made and extension of assignment requested for those which are still required.
3. Reference (a) further requested extension of the assignment of space on the Gun Mole presently occupied by the YFNL-16. This barge is located in an area which is designated for production operations, though not needed for such use at this time. Furthermore, the Shipyard contemplates regrading and repaving of the section of the Gun Mole on which the barge is located. At such time as the space is needed for production operations, or when funds become available to repair the area, it will be necessary to move the barge to a new location. Assignment of the space occupied by the barge is extended, on an indefinite basis, through 31 December 1958, subject to review and re-extension at that time, and also subject to cancellation for reasons stated above.
