Subj: Disposal of ex-YAG-39 (GEORGE EASTMAN)

1. The Secretary of the Navy has approved the striking of YAG-39 (GEORGE EASTMAN) as of 1 December 1975. Craft is located at INACTSHIPFAC Vallejo, CA.
2. It is requested that arrangements be made for the stripping (commencing 10 January 1976) and disposal of YAG-39. Craft should be reported to MARAD for final disposal.
3. By copy of this letter, GSA Regions 9 and 10 are advised that stripping action on YAG-39 will be held in abeyance until 10 January 1976. Craft will then be available for GSA transfer ~~for~~ donation action for an additional 45 days from commencement of stripping and disposal action. Copy of all transfer documents should be provided to this office.
