Subj: Shipment of 12 Curie Co⁶⁰ Source Shield

Dear Mr. Gillette:

We wish to thank you for the information contained in Mr. J.B. Henson's letter of 11 June 1951. All of our questions concerning shipment of multi-curie sources have been very satisfactorily answered. With the knowledge you have furnished, we feel that we are now in a position to make such shipments in accordance with the existing regulations.

Since our last letter concerning the proposed shipment for the 12 curie Co⁶⁰ source, we have received additional information indicating that shipment by Railway Express is the most desirable method. Tentatively, we expect to ship the shield to you around 1 August 1951 and will notify you when the shipping date is definitely established. We would prefer to have the source and shield returned via Railway Express when the loading has been completed.
