1. By paragraph 1.(e) of reference (a), the Commanding Officer, U. S. Naval Radiological Defense Laboratory, requested extension of the assignment of space occupied by the YFNX-16 on the regunning mole. The assignment of buildings also requested by reference (a) was made by reference (b).
2. - d. Building 510a - Kevatron facility with approximately 200 sq.ft. (510) of office space and access to mess' hall in Building 510.

Building 510a will be needed as a radiation facility in which it is planned to install a 1 MeV x-ray system by or before July 1956. This installation will require 510a building modifications to include adequate shielding to receive the x-ray installation. Details concerning this installation will be furnished in separate correspondence. Need for Building 510a will continue until replacement in like facility is available in the vicinity of Building 515 as planned under Public Works Program USNSBL Project 12ND-1135 (Essential) FY 1958 submission.

- e. Space on SPS Gun Hole - occupied by YFNS-16

YFNS-16 is at present the only semi-hot laboratory available to and in use by NSBL. Its use will be urgently needed until replacement in like facility is available as included in the planned Public Works Program USNSBL Project 12ND-1090 (Urgent) FY 1958 submission.

2. On review of continuing NSBL requirements for use of SPS space and buildings as set forth herein, it is found that to meet SPSBL program commitments, all above listed SPS space, buildings and parts thereof will be needed on a temporary indefinite basis until suitable facilities are available in the area of Building 515, or in event of mobilization, whichever is first. All NSBL facilities' projects of this nature are planned and are submitted for inclusion in Ship's Public Works Program for Fiscal Year 1958.
