1. In accordance with reference (a), the following is submitted to be added to the history of the USS GEORGE EASTMAN (YAG 39).

During 1965, USS GEORGE EASTMAN continued in her role as research vessel supporting various scientific reasearch projects participating in extensive test series during May and, remaining at sea for 42 days in the equatorial area of the mid-pacific. Again in August and September the ship deployed in the mid-pacific for another test series. Much time was necessarily spent in shipyard modifications preparing for these projects. Late in the year, the entire topside area of the ship was sandblasting to bare metal, coated with special Zinc and Epoxy paints preparing the EASTMAN for another year of testing and research.
