1. Reference (a) established the Shipyard Space Control Program and assigned responsibility for administering the program to the Space Control Officer (Code 140).
2. In accordance with the above-noted responsibilities, the assignment of buildings and open areas to Shipyard departments, and commands located on the Shipyard, as of 1 June 1956 is as follows:
  - a. Building space within the Shipyard, as shown on enclosure (1).
  - b. Off-yard space, as shown on enclosure (2).
  - c. Buildings assigned to other departments for space reassignment, as shown on enclosure (3).
  - d. To the Public Works Officer, in addition to enclosure (1), all rest rooms, halls, cleaning equipment spaces, and building service spaces in Shipyard office-type buildings.
  - e. Open areas as currently authorized by San Francisco Naval Shipyard Building and Space Assignment Notices.
3. Security and housekeeping responsibilities outlined in references (b) and (c) will change with changes in space assignments. For those buildings having


