Dear Pauline:

Since your departure from NBDL a question has arisen about the radiation exposure as recorded by the film badge you wore during November, the last month of your employment.

The badge indicates a gamma exposure in excess of what we think you would have gotten in the normal course of your duties. Bio-Med records show that on 1 November you were irradiating animals at the Cobalt 60 exposure facility in Bldg. 517. It has occurred to us that your film badge may have been inadvertently left, for a time, in the exposure room during the time the source was in the exposed position.

If this was the case, or if you have some other knowledge of your receiving, or your badge receiving, an exposure in excess of one roentgen, we would appreciate it if you would give us the information. We would like to bring your exposure record up to date so that an accurate record may be transferred to your next place of employment with a minimum of inconvenience.
